Consequences

Having sex without consent and sexual assault could result in the perpetrator being added to the Sex Offender Register	Physical injury	Mental health problems including depression and anxiety
Emotional upset	Fear	Internal injury
Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) for both people and any other future partner	Possible custodial sentence if found guilty of rape or sexual assault	Problems trusting future partners/forming new relationships
Sexual assault could lead to a community order, fine or prison sentence	Unwanted pregnancy	Embarrassment or shame
Lower self-esteem and sense of worth	Humiliation	Having a criminal record, and/or being put on the Sex Offenders' Register will have major impact on future life events such as getting work
